## 34<sup>th</sup> International Senshusei Course Program

**Required age**: 18 to 40 years (male or female). Please note that the course is considered extremely physically challenging.

Required Aikido level: None.

**Required Japanese language level**: Some Japanese is recommended, although many students undertake the course with no knowledge of Japanese.

Course duration: April 2<sup>nd</sup> to December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2024 (9 months)

\*Orientation will be held at the end of March (attendance is obligatory). The date will be announced later.

## **Yearly Schedule**

**Required visa**: Entry with a tourist visa. After some trial period Honbu Dojo will sponsor committed individuals for a cultural visa (this is classified as a non-working visa, and for the visa application the individual will need to demonstrate the financial ability to cover living expenses)

Location: Yoshinkan Aikido Honbu Dojo (Takadanobaba, Tokyo, Japan)

Tuition fees: JPY 33,000 per month.

There are extra costs besides monthly tuition;

JPY 11,000 (entrance fee), JPY 3,300 (registration fee) JPY 1,650 (textbook) and, if needed, approx. JPY 8,360 (dogi size4) \*3set at the beginning of the course.

approx. JPY 25,000 (summer camp fee) in July,

JPY 14,670 (Shodan fee) and JPY27,500 (instructor's license fee) upon passing the corresponding tests

\*Entrance fee, Registration fee, Textbook fee and 3 months' tuition should be paid by February 29th, 2024. Cancellations received after the 8-day cancellation period which will start from the day of the payment will not be eligible for refund. We will refund the tuition and fees, if the course is cancelled before the start due to insufficient enrolment (3 participants minimum) or other unforeseen circumstances.

**Equipment:** No equipment is necessary; however, participants will need at least three set of dogi for the year. These are available for purchase at Honbu dojo.

Course capacity: 6 persons.

**Application process**: prepare documents 1-3 as below and send to Honbu dojo in an envelope marked "Senshusei Application".

- 1. Senshusei application form (two sheets)
- 2. Doctor's note in English (stating you are both mentally and physically in healthy condition)
- 3. Resume
